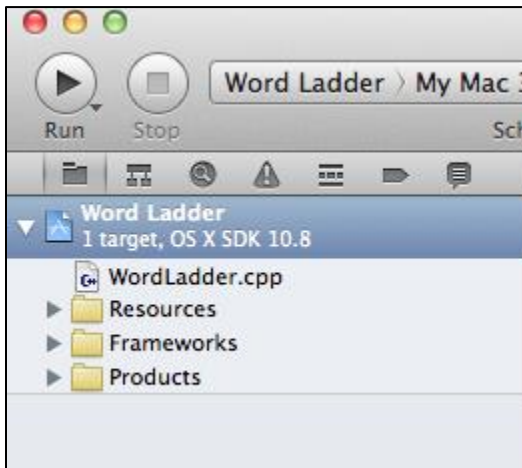


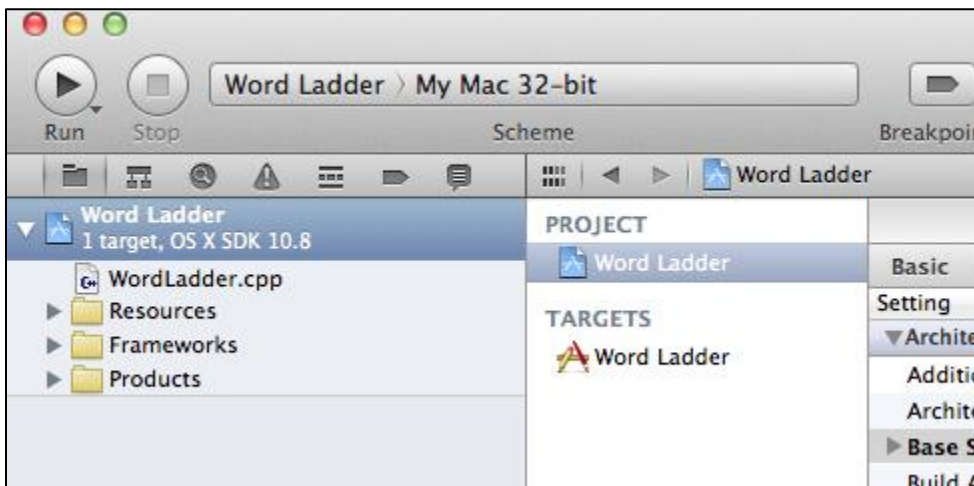
Fix for Xcode Errors

A number of students running Xcode across multiple versions of OS X have reported encountering various errors when opening the assignment starter files. I've put this handout together to detail a fix that appears to address the vast majority of these issues.

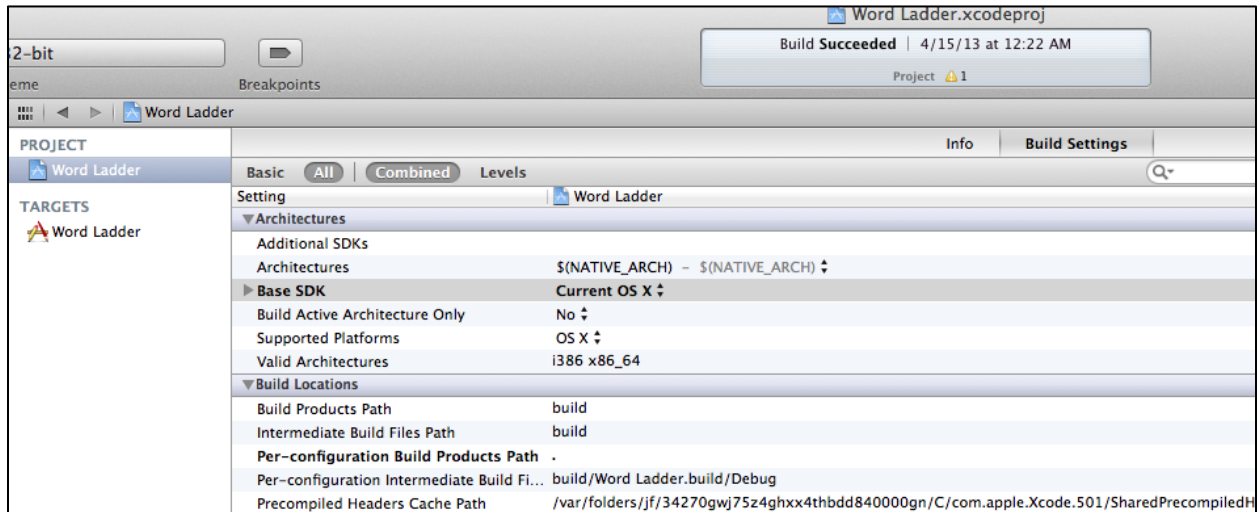
1. Open the project by opening the .xcodeproj file provided in the starter code.
2. In the left-hand panel, select the project. The project will become selected, as shown below.



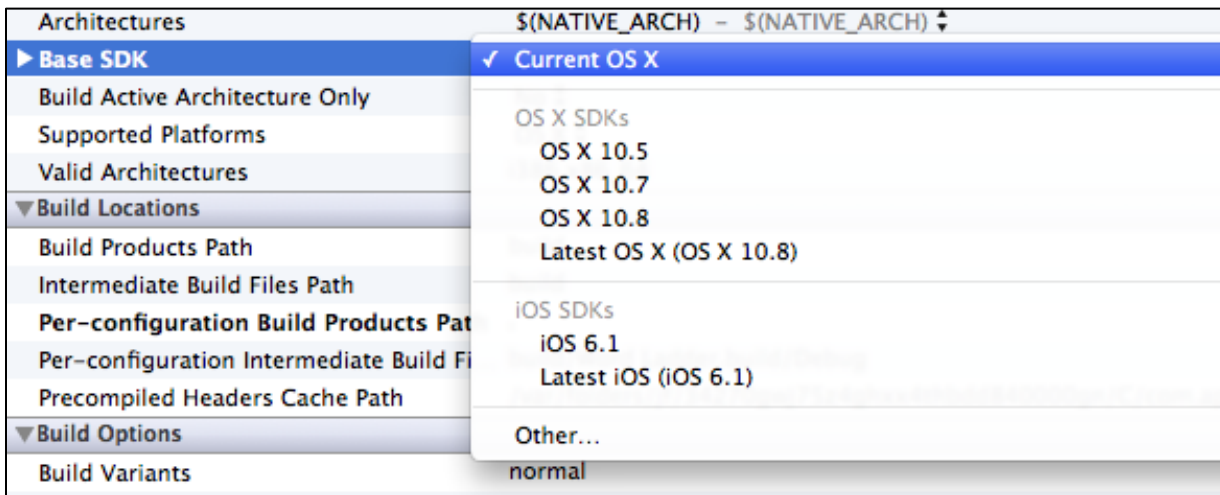
3. A new settings window will open up. You should see two categories of settings: "Project" and "Targets." You will need to modify settings for both. First, select the project under the "Project" section.



- In the settings window, make sure that “Build Settings” is selected, and that you’re looking at “All” settings.



- The setting of interest here is “Base SDK.” Make sure that it is set to “Current OS X” or whichever version of OS X you’re running.



- Repeat steps 4 and 5 for the project settings under the “Targets” section.
