

Glynn Lunney is the McGlinchey Stafford Professor of Law at Tulane University School of Law. He holds an engineering degree from Texas A&M, a law degree from Stanford, and a Ph.D. in economics from Tulane. Professor Lunney teaches and writes in the fields of contract, property, and intellectual property, with a focus on the economic analysis of legal issues. He has recently published a casebook, *TRADEMARKS AND UNFAIR COMPETITION* (WEST 2010), and has also published articles in leading law reviews, including reviews at Harvard, Stanford, Michigan, Virginia, Vanderbilt, Emory, and Tulane.
