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**WYOMING'S STATUS REPORT NO. 3**

1. On March 26, 27 and 28, 2012, Montana reviewed Wyoming documents in Cheyenne, Laramie, Casper and Sheridan, Wyoming. Documents identified for production by Montana are being Bates numbered and copied.

2. On March 19, 2012, Montana served answers to Wyoming's First Set of Interrogatories. Wyoming has stated to Montana that it disagrees with some of Montana's objections and is dissatisfied with some of the answers and these two parties are conferring on this issue, working from a written list of concerns that Wyoming provided to Montana by letter.

3. Montana expects to provide on April 9, 2012 Bates numbered digital copies of documents Wyoming identified from its document inspection in Helena during the last week of February. Montana also expects to serve its response to Wyoming's First Request for Production of Documents on April 9, 2012.

4. With the cooperation of Montana, Wyoming has scheduled the depositions of five witnesses identified by Montana in its initial disclosures. Those depositions will be held on April 18, and 23-26, 2012 in Helena and Billings, Montana.

5. Montana has raised with Wyoming the possibility that Montana will request an extension of certain deadlines. The parties have communicated orally and in writing about Montana's potential request.
