CASE MANAGEMENT ORDER NO. 1

Both the State of Wyoming and Amicus Anadarko Petroleum Corporation have filed Requests for Modification of Case Management Order. The Special Master has reviewed those requests, the State of Montana's Response to Anadarko's request, and Anadarko's reply in support of its request.

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED THAT:

1. Oral Argument.

The State of Montana and the State of Wyoming will each have an hour for its oral argument. The United States of America, as amicus curiae, will have 20 minutes. These times are guidelines that the parties and the United States should use in preparing their oral arguments. If it proves important at the hearing to provide either party or the United States with additional time in order to adequately explore the issues raised by the State of Wyoming's motion to dismiss, the Special Master has the authority to provide the parties or the United States with such time. The State of Wyoming also can reserve a portion of its hour for rebuttal of the arguments of Montana and the United States.

2. Request of Anadarko Petroleum Corporation

Amicus Anadarko Petroleum Corporation's Request for Modification of Case Management Order and for Divided Argument is denied.
