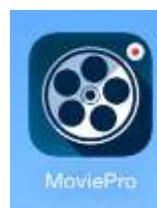

Turn on the shotgun microphone



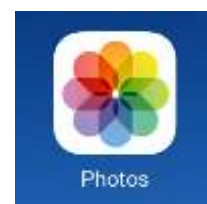
Click the icon 'MoviePro' to launch the video app

Use the app to record and upload the file in a web browser

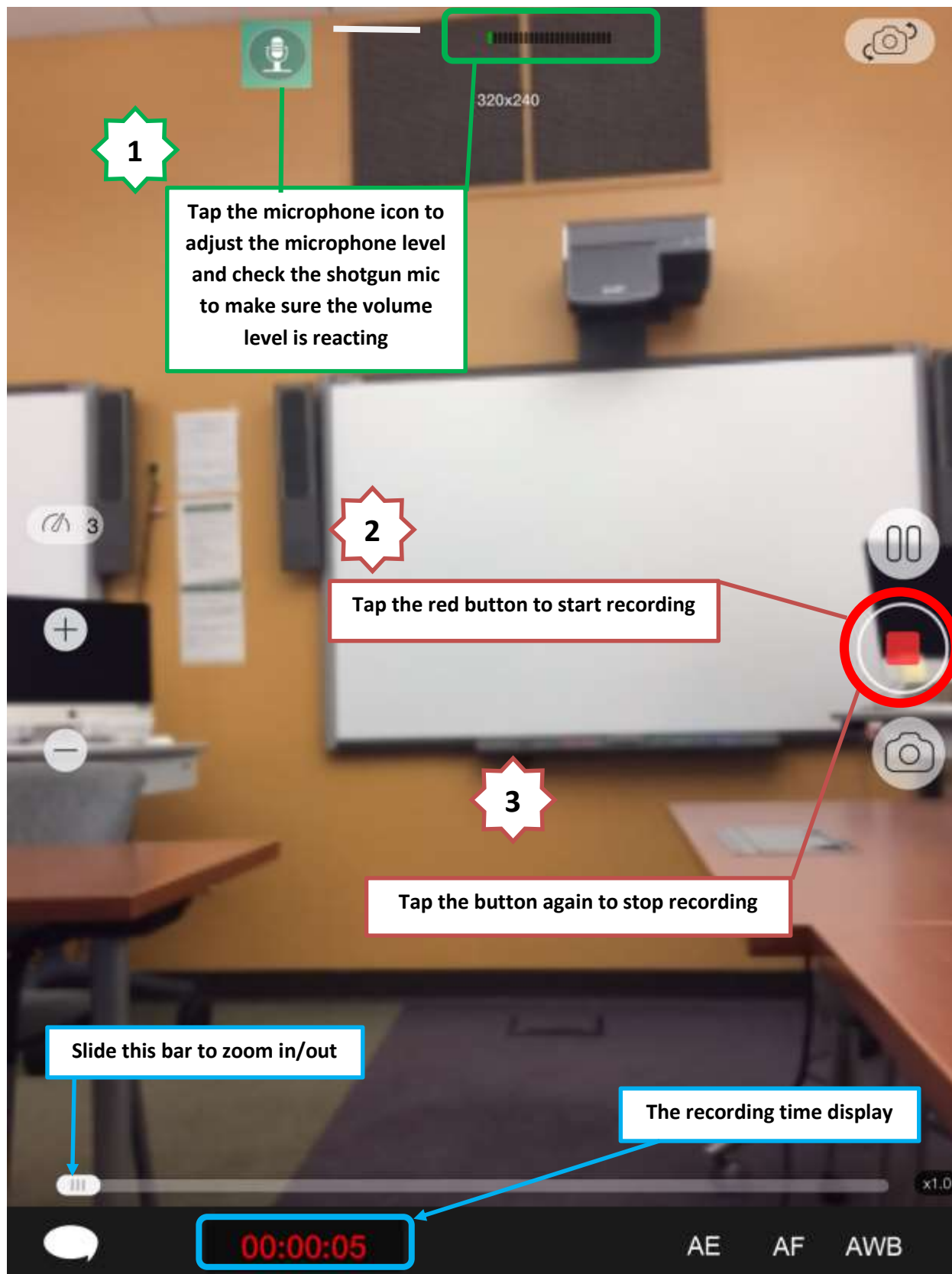
1. Click the red button to start recording. The recording time is displaying on the bottom.
2. Click the button again to stop recording. The video footage will be exported to your Camera Roll

[Note]

- To check the video file, tap 'Photos' and then 'Camera Roll'



Recommendation: If you plan to record more than 15 minutes of presentation, you may want to stop and restart the recording every 15 minutes and upload them as separate files (part 1, part2, etc), so that the file size will not exceed the upload limit in CourseWork.



Estimated Benchmarks (click the ‘gear icon’ on the bottom of the app to configure the setting.

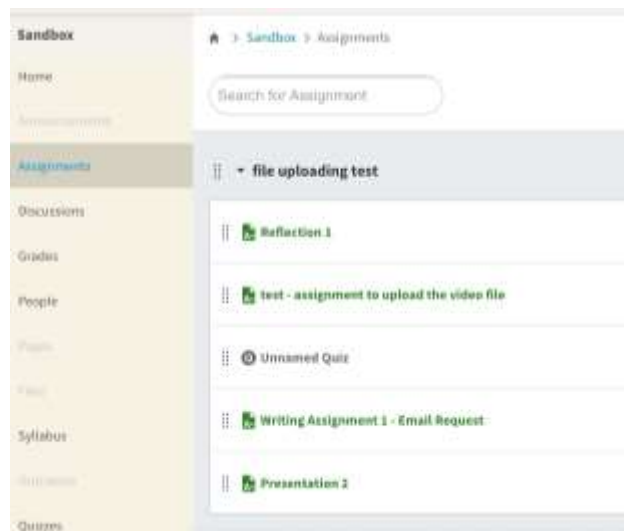

Upload the file in Canvas

Open the Safari Browser and access Canvas



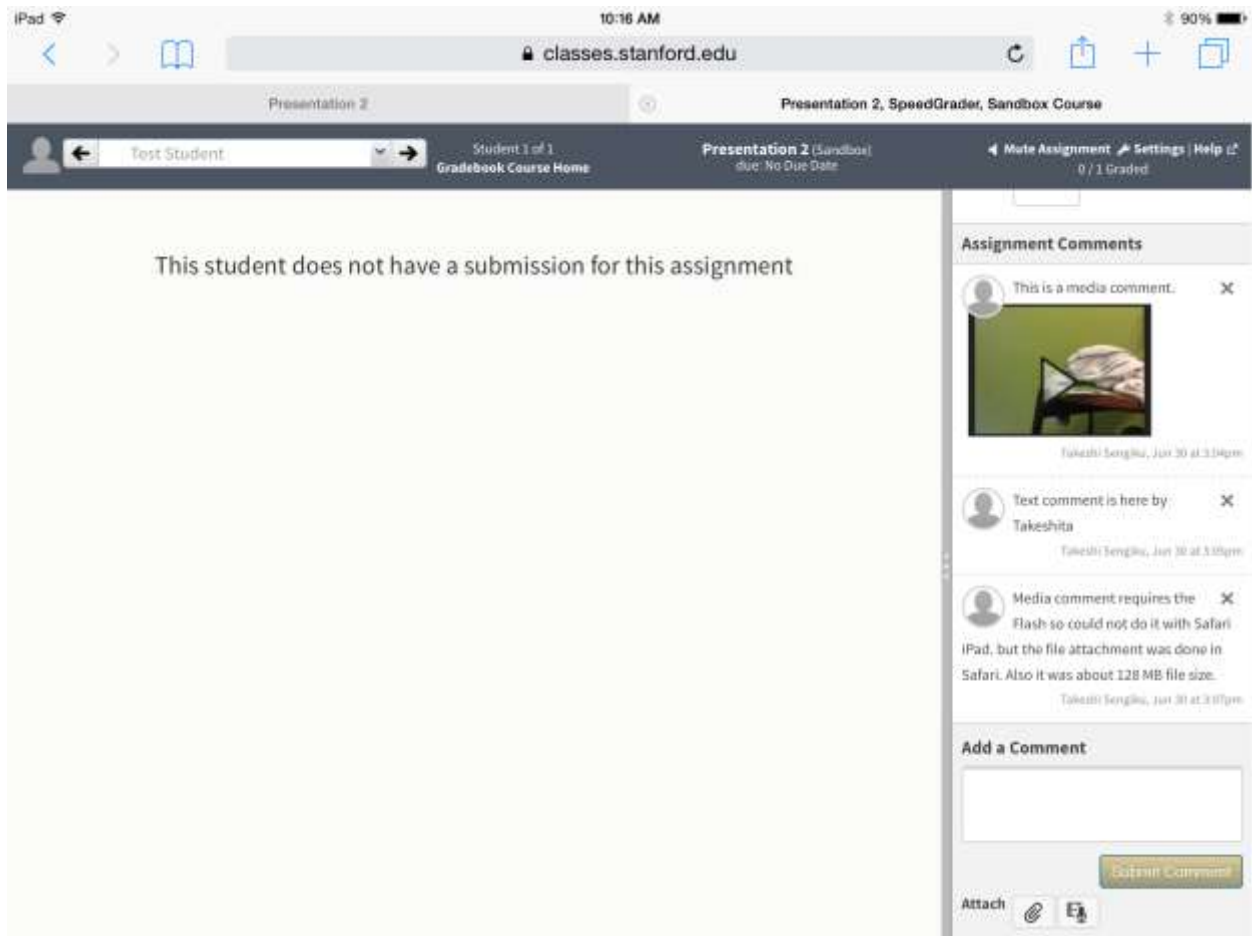
Go to your Course, click Assignments and select the assignment where you want to upload the video file



Click the 'SpeedGrader' link on the right side.

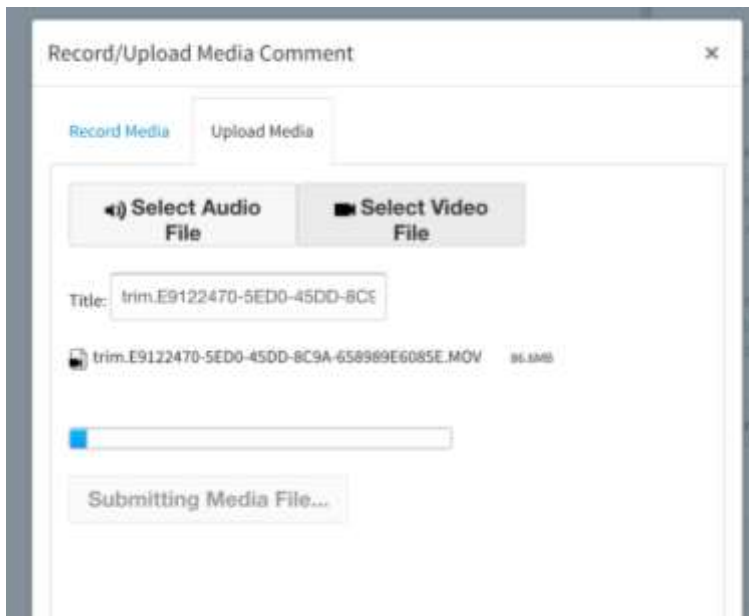
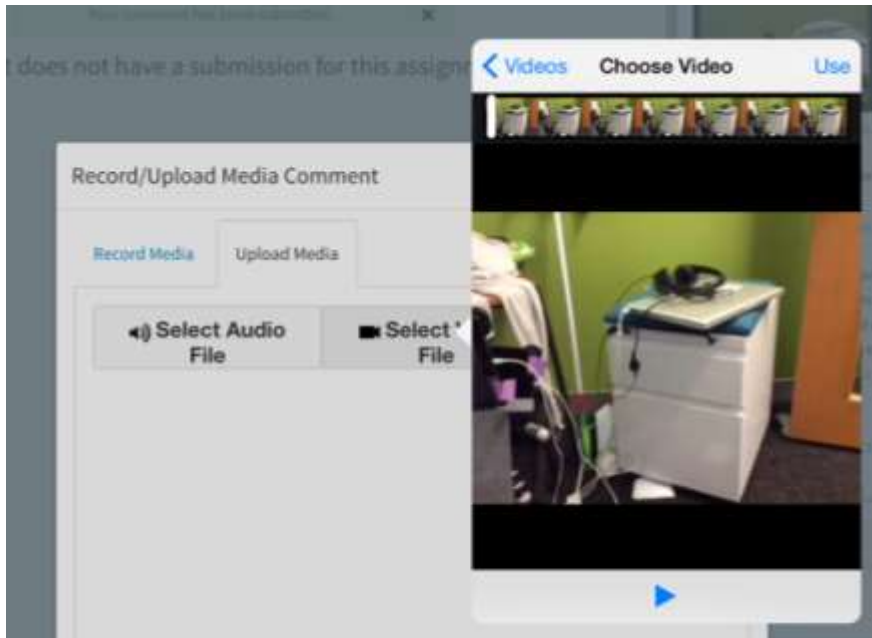

Either way, you will select a specific file through the 'Photo Library'. You will specify the video file from 'Camera Roll' or 'Video'. Click 'Use' to start uploading the file.

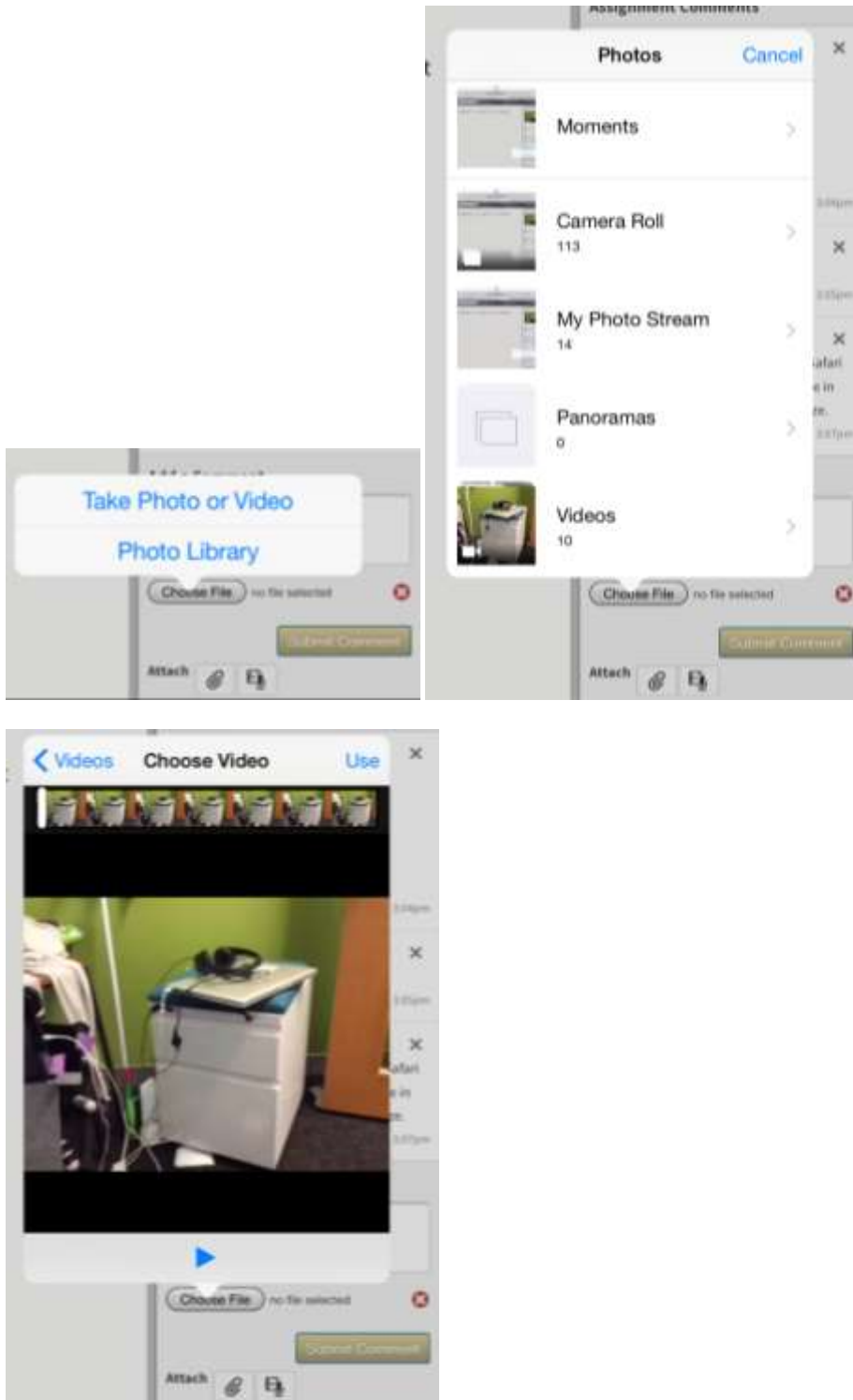


Embedded by using 'Media Comment'
