

- Repetitive reminders

Re-Pete

- Game which tests ability to remember visual and auditory patterns
- Mac only (System 6.0.7 or better – OS X version is best)
- Used for memory enhancement
- Accommodates hard of hearing/deaf by providing visual cues to participate

Responding Heads 3

- Enables the user to launch programs, commands, and actions via voice commands
- Uses Microsoft Speech recognition engine
- Requires user configuration
- “Responding Head” provides visual feedback

SayO Clock 1.2.1

- Software is for Windows NT/2000/XP
- Tells time out loud
- Speaks on demand or according to a schedule

Single Switch Performance Test (SSPT)

- Software to facilitate measurement of the ability to activate a single switch
- Available for Windows and Mac (Java version)
- Measures the average time required to activate or release a switch (after visual and/or audio prompts)
- Can measure the speed of repetitive activations

Speak and Mail 2000

- Notifies the user when new mail arrives by reading the message header and contents according to preferences
- Supports multiple email accounts
- Listen to email, webpages, etc.
- Features voice recognition which can be used to launch applications or websites

Speak for Yourself™

- Augmentative communication program that runs on Windows XP
- 56 buttons, completely customizable to the user!
- One-to-many, face-to-face communication
- Operates in scan mode or direct select mode
- Buttons can be assigned any word or phrase
- Stores the individual's name, school, hobbies and interests, etc





- Keep track of those important Birthdays by ticking Other Detail on the Contact screen and adding in their birthday. Check the Auto create birthday event if you would like the program to automatically add a repeating event in your calendar.
- You can use UVC to broadcast audio and video by going to the Tools top menu item and selecting Broadcast Media.
- Send an email to someone right from UVC by going to the address book and clicking on their email address from the main screen. UVC will then launch your default email program.
