

Iraq withdraws from Kuwait frontier post

Kuwait, April 5.—Iraqi forces today withdrew from the Kuwait frontier post at Al Samita which they occupied in a border clash on March 20, authoritative sources said in Kuwait.

An Iraqi delegation is expected here tomorrow to discuss the dispute, which has kept tension high between the two countries since occupation of the border post.

It was reported that the Iraqi forces were withdrawing from all occupied positions. They began pulling out late today and 19 heavy lorries, carrying weapons left the Al Samita area in the direction of Iraq.—Agence France Presse.
