

# ISRAELIS SAY U.A.R. KIDNAPPED EXPERT

TEL AVIV, Sept. 19 (Reuters)

—The newspaper Haboker reported today that Dr. Heinz Krug, a West German rocket expert who disappeared in Munich on Sept. 11, had been abducted by Egyptian agents to prevent a last-minute business deal with an Israeli concern.

The newspaper said the Israeli concern had offered to buy Dr. Krug's Intra Trading Company of Stuttgart, which is reported to have supplied the United Arab Republic with rocket parts. When Dr. Krug, 49-year-old former manager of the Stuttgart Research Institute for Jet Propulsion Physics, vanished eight days ago, his wife declared: "My husband was kidnapped."

Haboker said that Dr. Krug's company recently negotiated with the Israeli concern that was to take over the business and its staff.

The pro-Government newspaper Al Akhbar said Israeli intelligence had been ordered to kidnap all scientists working on rockets, aircraft or atomic weapons for the United Arab Republic or cooperating in such projects.
