- More focus on strategy and not low level excel work (that can be assigned as homework)
- I found this class to be one of the most directly relevant to my post INSEAD career objectives. I, however, found that I needed much more time to practice concepts learned in class and fell behind quite quickly. I decided not to attend all the class but instead spend 4-6 hours in my personal time watching the videos and learning to use python which I wasn't able to complete by the end of the last class. I would suggest that if possible classes are only 2 hrs long (or just the normal 90min) and spread out over a longer time span. The double sessions did not provide me with the time I needed to fully grasp the material.
