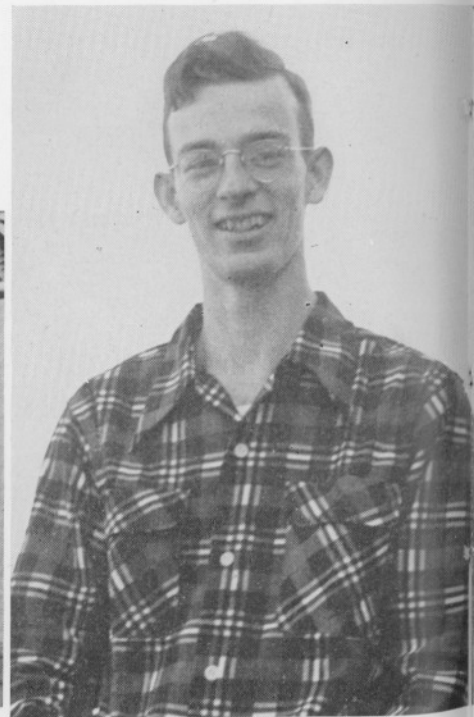


ALPINE CLUB
