Dihydrogen monoxide is colourless, odorless, tasteless, and kills uncounted thousands of people every year. - May cause severe burns.
- Has been found in tumors of cancer patients.
- Contributes to the erosion of our natural landscape.

Despite the danger, dihydrogen monoxide is often used:

- As an industrial solvent and coolant.

- In nuclear power plants.
- As an additive in certain "junk-foods" and other food products.
- In the production of styrofoam.
- As a fire retardant.
- In many forms of cruel animal research.
