What makes a good project?

- Impactful
- Something you are passionate about
- Fits within next eight weeks of work
- Has meaningful intermediate milestones
- Fits the skills and background of your team
- As you work on it, it will probably change. That is OK. (And expected!)

Key Questions to Ask

- Who is your customer? Who are you building this for?
 - Precisely define your ideal customer profile
 - Can you meet and talk with these people?
- What is the burning-need problem you are solving for them?
 - What is their life like now? How does it change if this exists?
 - Is it 10x better than alternatives?
 - Will they be angry if you take it away from them?
- Impact: How many of those people are there in the world?
- Bonus: Are people willing/able to pay for it? (In money, attention, data, etc.)
