


Remembering Carl Hewitt

Carl Hewitt, an eminent AI researcher, visionary computer scientist, emeritus MIT faculty, and frequent EE380 speaker died December 7th 2022 at his home in Aptos, California. A memorial gathering was held on a rainy Saturday in Santa Cruz on January 14th followed by a well attended Zoom reception.

EE380 for January 18th 4PM will be a lightly moderated open Zope forum to discuss Carl's contributions to Computer Science and Engineering and recognize their significance.
