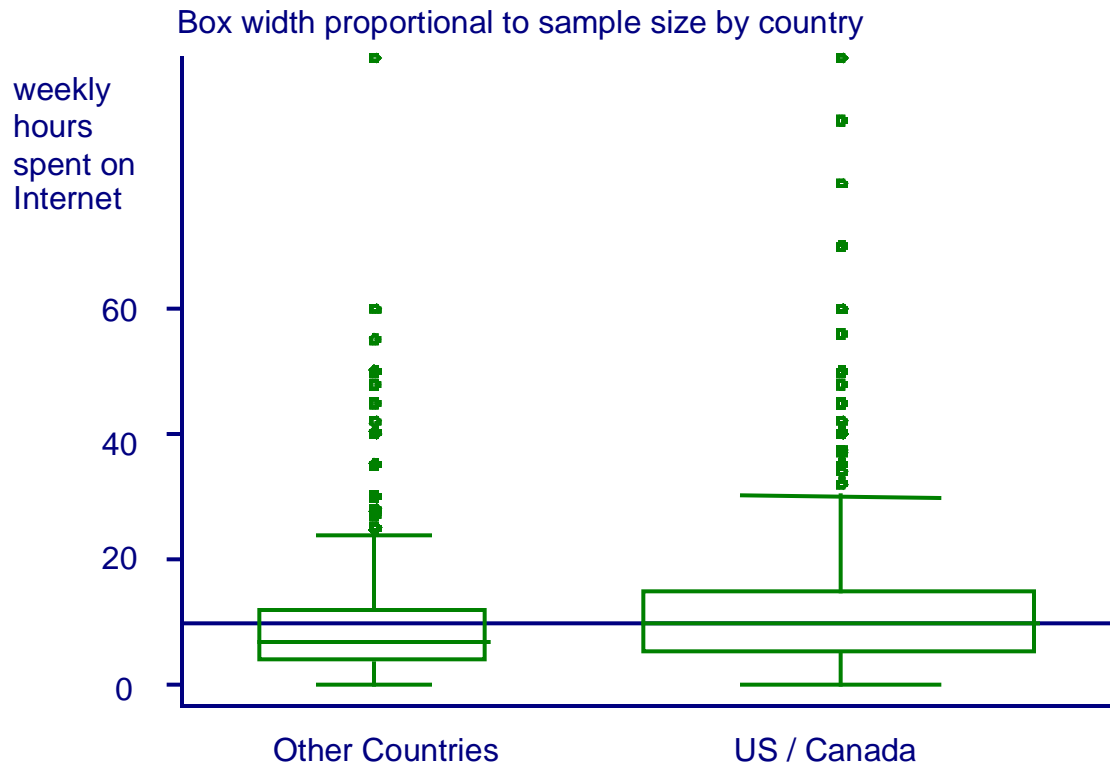

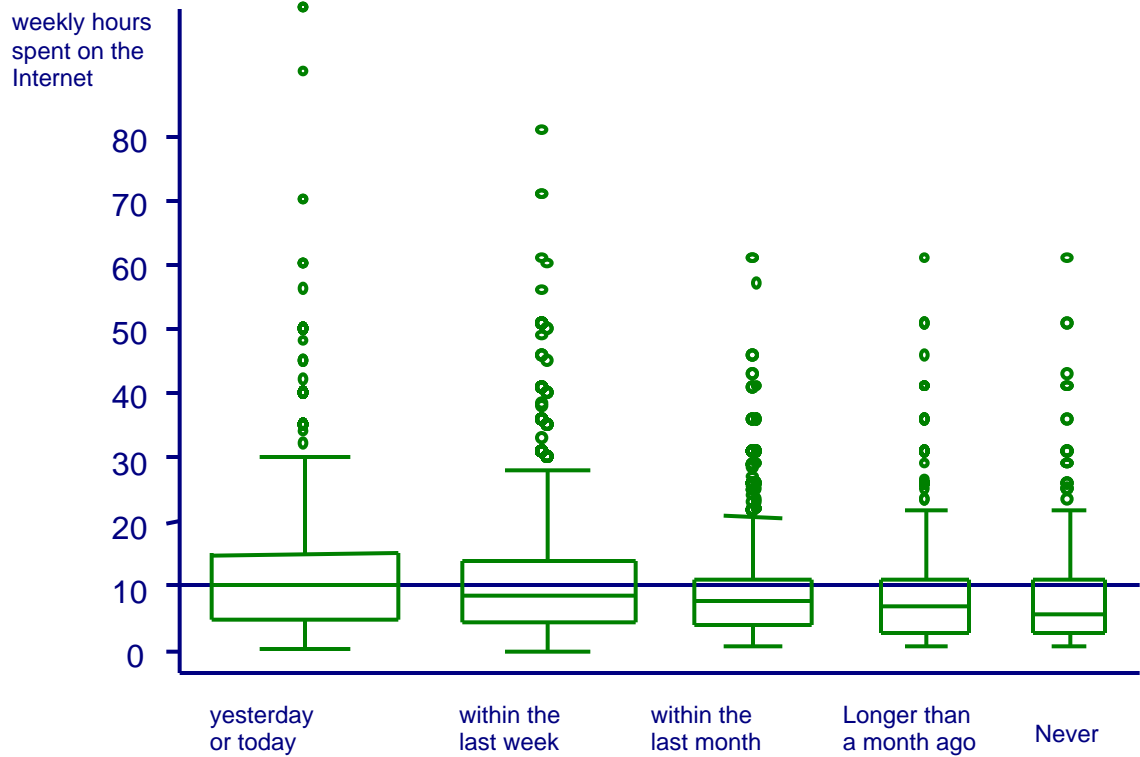

The lines emerging from the box extend to the upper and lower adjacent values. Observed points more extreme than adjacent points referred to as outside values are individually plotted. A box width is proportional to the square root of the number of observations (sum of the weights). A line extending from the Y axis represents 10.
