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Introduction

- **Definition of Web 2.0**

- “Web-based applications and services that provide users visual, textual, audial communication, interactive information, shared content, collaboration, authenticity and digital literacy” (O’Reilly, 2005; Yalcin, 2011)
- Web 2.0 is a concept that takes the network as a platform for information sharing, interoperability, user-centered design, and collaboration on the World Wide Web.” (from Wikipedia)



Introduction (Cont.)

- **Examples of Web 2.0**
 - Blogs: Facebook, Twitter, etc.
 - Wikis
 - Tagging and social bookmarking
 - Multimedia sharing
 - Audio blogging and podcasting
 - Content syndication

Introduction (Cont.)

- **Features of Web 2.0**
 - Participatory information sharing
 - User-friendly
 - Collaboration and contribution
 - Synchronous and asynchronous interaction among users (active communication and feedback available)



Introduction (Cont.)

- **Pedagogical Benefits of Web 2.0**
 - Increases students' motivation (Lam, 2000)
 - Provides effective educational tools allowing collaboration, communication and interaction among students
(Lee, 2005; Oskoz & Thorne, 2008)
