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PROFOUND (CDR 4)

- 4 Profound. Speech usually unintelligible or irrelevant; unable to follow simple instructions or comprehend commands; occasionally recognizes spouse or caregiver. Uses fingers more than utensils, requires much assistance. Frequently incontinent despite assistance or training. Able to walk a few steps with help; usually chair-bound; rarely out of home or residence; purposeless movements often present.
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TERMINAL (CDR 5)

- 5 Terminal. No response or comprehension. No recognition. Needs to be fed, may have NG tube and/or swallowing difficulties. Total incontinence. Bedridden, unable to sit or stand, contractures.
