Finger Praxis

Participants are instructed to imitate each of the five finger positions, one at a time, as the examiner demonstrates. The examiner directly faces the participant and continues to demonstrate each position statically until the participant feels that he or she has accurately reproduced it [10 sec. maximum per position].

The position is correct when the interlocking finger component is accurate regardless of positioning of the non-interlocking fingers or posture of the arms (figures 1-4), or when the thumb of one hand touches the index finger of the opposite hand to create a quadrilateral space (figure 5). For figures in which hand positions are not symmetric, a mirror image response (left/ right hand reversal) is scored as correct.

Transitive limb praxis

Demonstration: "I'm going to ask you to pretend to do some things. For example, Show me how you would pretend to pick up a screwdriver and turn screw. "[For the demonstration task only, if incorrect, say "Watch me" and show the participant the correct response. Then say, "Now, you try it again. Show me how you would pretend to pick up a screwdriver and turn a screw."]

Scoring:

- 3, Normal.
- 2, Recognizable (including body part as object or closing in).
- 1, Unsuccessful attempt (paramimia; vocalization).
- 0, Unrecognizable or no response. Do not score the "picking up" part of the command.
