


Dr. Thomas Rutherford



Professor Thomas F. Rutherford earned a PhD in Operations Research from Stanford University under the direction of Alan S. Manne. He has subsequently been a faculty member at the University of Western Ontario, the University of Colorado, and the ETH Zurich before joining the University of Wisconsin in 2012.

Professor Rutherford's research focuses on the formulation, solution and application of numerical equilibrium models for economic issues in environmental economics, international trade and economic growth. His work has focused on the economic analysis of global warming, the economic consequences of multi-regional trade agreements, the economic effects of trade reform in small open economies.
