We will be ordering the pizza the day before the contest, so your registration must be received by Thursday, February 26th to order. If you would like pizza for lunch, please indicate in the space below how many and what kind.

The early registration deadline is February 17, 2009. If your registration is postmarked on or before that date, the cost of the contest will be \$5.00 per student (\$2.50 per subject test, \$5 per general test), plus \$1 for each student taking the team test. For registration postmarked on or after February 17th and received by the contest date, the cost will be \$6.00 per student (\$3.00 per subject test, \$6 per general test) and \$2 for each student taking the team test. If you plan to register when you arrive at the contest, or your registration materials have not been received by the morning of February 23, the cost will be \$7.00 per student (\$3.50 per subject test, \$7 per general test) and \$3 for each student taking the team test.
