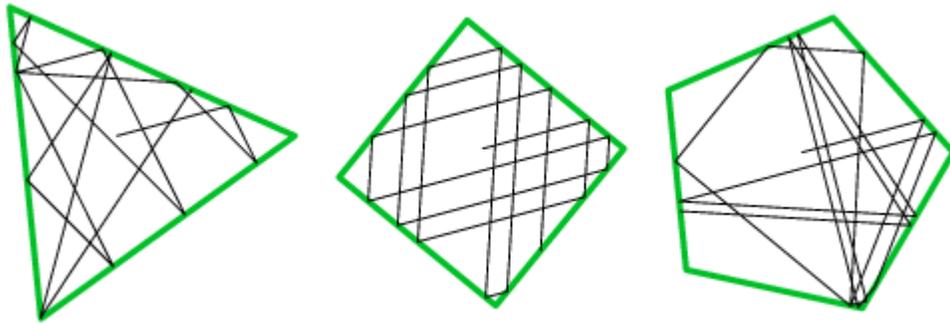

Polygonal Billiards

ABSTRACT:

Bored playing billiards on a rectangular table? Ever wonder what would happen if the table was triangular or L-shaped? Billiards on polygonal tables has become a mathematical topic of particular interest in recent years. We'll discuss ways of thinking about them, particularly when all of the angles are rational multiples of π . Then one looks at geodesics on a surface constructed from copies of the table.
