

Abstract: In how many ways can we express the number n as a sum of positive integers? This problem can be attacked by using some very powerful ideas in combinatorics, and it was also the inspiration for the Hardy-Littlewood circle method in analytic number theory. We'll look at some of these methods and see how they apply to this and other closely related problems.
