**Final phases of PG&E  
work on Sand Hill Road:  
Roadway restoration  
begins soon**

Dear Valued Customer:

Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) is working to build a safer, stronger natural gas system. As part of our ongoing system-wide program to ensure the safety our pipelines, and with your patience and cooperation, we have replaced a portion of our natural gas transmission system in Menlo Park. The new pipeline is safer, stronger, and better serves your community. With that work complete, we are excited to begin the final phase of this project: Sand Hill Road will be repaved and restored.

**Final PG&E work on Sand Hill Road: Roadway restoration**

Beginning on or around June 24th through June 29th, PG&E will restore all areas of Sand Hill Road that have been disturbed by the gas pipeline construction, although weather and other factors affecting safe working conditions could change the schedule. After the paving on Sand Hill Road is finished, you may see PG&E and its contractors working at various sites in Menlo Park and Stanford to complete final restoration and cleanup through July 31st.

Initial restoration work will begin in the evening, as crews grind off 2 inches of the existing temporary pavement to prepare to apply the permanent rubberized asphalt during the daytime. Grinding operations will continue for the next three to four evenings, with placement of the new roadway surface taking place during the subsequent daytime hours. By scheduling the grinding work during the evenings, the project schedule and corresponding impacts to daytime traffic is shortened considerably.

**Please plan ahead for traffic impacts**

The repaving work that will take place during daytime hours will affect traffic on Sand Hill Road for the week of June 24th. PG&E will clearly mark all work areas, and traffic flaggers will help to direct traffic. Please plan for delays when driving through this area, or look for alternate routes when possible.
