

## Call for Papers NSE 12 - Luxembourg Oct 23-25, 2026

This is a call for papers for the twelfth conference in the series on Network Science and Economics. The conference will take place at the University of Luxembourg from **October 23 through 25, 2026**, hosted by local organizers Christos Koulovatianos and Zaruhi Hakobyan, with the support of the University of Luxembourg and the FNR.

In keeping with the previous editions, the conference seeks papers on the broad theme of social and economic networks.

The deadline for all submissions is **July 31, 2026**. Papers should be submitted [via Oxford Abstracts](#) (you'll need to sign up for a free Oxford Abstracts account if you don't have one).

We will have a program committee consisting of Margherita Comola, Andrea Galeotti, and Ana Mauleon who will handle the submissions and organize the program. Decisions will be communicated in late August 2026.

While extended abstracts are acceptable, full papers are encouraged. The presenter should make the submission and there is a limit of one submission per presenter (but a presenter can be a coauthor on other submissions). Early-career scholars are especially encouraged to submit papers. With the closure of the economics division of the US National Science Foundation, we will no longer be able to offer assistance for travel expenses. Please note that no conference proceedings will be published.

Given the continuously growing demand for the NSE conference series, we will have two iterations of the NSE series each year – one in North America in the spring and one on another continent in the fall. This will be the first European edition. Researchers are welcome to participate in both iterations.
