- Manage risk by calculating real time unsecured bank credit usage and minimize payment risk by systematically releasing payment messages based on credit availability
- Forecast and fund efficiently by providing start of day, intraday, and end of day projected and actual cash positions across all currencies, legal entities and bank accounts
- Supply robust BCP/DR capabilities
- Provide scalability to handle changes in business volume/mix
- Offer 'plug and play' capability for new businesses and acquisitions
