## Korean regulator says KDB talks with Lehman ended

LONDON (MarketWatch) -- South Korea's Financial Services Commission Chairman Jun Kwang-woo said Tuesday that talks between state-run Korea Development Bank and Lehman Brothers Holdings Inc. have ended, Dow Jones Newswires reported. He declined to say what conclusions, if any, had been

reached, the report said.
