

RESOLUTION NO. 306

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN
OF LOS ALTOS HILLS REQUESTING PROVISION OF
NON-VEHICULAR WAYS THROUGH INTERCHANGE

WHEREAS it appears that the interchange at the intersection of Interstate Route 280 (also known as Junipero Serra Freeway) and Page Mill Road, as presently planned indicates construction of certain sidewalks but makes no appropriate provision for pedestrian, equestrian and bicycle traffic, and

WHEREAS Page Mill Road has carried such traffic for many years and the volume thereof may be expected to increase substantially upon the opening of recreational facilities in the area,

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of Los Altos Hills that the Division of Highways of the State of California be and said Division is hereby urgently requested to take account of non-vehicular traffic, specifically equestrian traffic, upon Page Mill Road, existing and future, in the plan and design of the interchange in question and to make safe, practical and aesthetically attractive provision for such traffic.


