1. Reading for the topic of pronoun case (the next two weeks): MWDEU entry on **pronouns** and the entries on **between you and I; but; I; it's me; me; myself; possessive with gerund; than; they, their, them; who, whom; yourself, yourselves.**

Be prepared to discuss some of the MWDEU entries – in particular, to discuss things you have trouble understanding in these entries. Question to think about: How do we tell whether a word is being used as a preposition or a conjunction?
3. For F 20 May, to turn in as written homework: a collection of 10-20 examples illustrating (potential) problems with pronoun case, of as many different types as you can manage. As usual, these should be examples that you collected yourself. For each example, explain briefly what the problem might be, citing relevant sections of MWDEU.
4. For M 23 May, to turn in as written homework: a progress report on your project, several pages in length. In class, we'll discuss the homework on pronoun case.
5. On W 25 May, we'll discuss your progress reports and continue the discussion of pronoun case.
6. On F 27 May, we'll finish the discussion of pronoun case.
